



Hello Pet Parents:

Thank you for choosing Camp Countryside for your doggie daycare needs. Enclosed please find all of the necessary information and paperwork to get your dog enrolled at our facility. Please review the documentation carefully, as we do have very strict requirements for your dog to attend our daycare program. The reason for this is that we are a hospital first and foremost. We strive to ensure the best health and well-being of all pets in our care.

Once the enclosed documents are completed and the requirements have been met, we can then schedule your dog's first day of camp. First days are always a half day (6 hour maximum) and we require drop off as close to 7:00am as possible. This is to ensure that introductions and acclimation to our pack is a smooth and pleasant experience for all of our Campers. We require pick up by 1:00pm on this first day so as not to overwhelm your dog.

We recommend you keep a copy of all of the enclosed paperwork for your records prior to returning it to our facility. Please note that pricing is subject to change without notice and new pricelists are always available at the Camp Office or you can request one via email.

Camp Calendars are made available for the upcoming month by the 2nd Monday of the current month. Reservations cannot be made for the upcoming month prior to that day in order to keep things fair. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis. Purchase of a multi-day package does not guarantee a reservation.

You may email the required medical/vaccine and test records from your primary veterinarian, along with the completed paperwork (enclosed) to our hospital at vet@cvhonline.com, or you can drop them off in person. Once all requirements are met and received, you may call to schedule your dog's first day of camp if our staff has not already reached out to you.

CAMP COUNTRYSIDE

Requirements

The following list outlines the requirements for attending our day care facility. Please note that we will not schedule your dog for Camp until all requirements have been met and as often as noted for continued attendance. We recommend bringing this list to your vet to avoid missing a required vaccine or test.

- 🐾 **Rabies Vaccine** – typically every 3 years after the 1st year of age.
- 🐾 **Distemper Vaccine** – typically every 3 years after the 1st year of age.
- 🐾 **Leptospirosis Vaccine** – required annually.
- 🐾 **Canine Influenza Vaccine** – required annually.
- 🐾 **Bordetella or Kennel Cough Vaccine** – required every 6 months.
- 🐾 **Heartworm Test with negative result** – required annually (at 1 year old).
- 🐾 **Intestinal Parasite or Fecal Test** – required annually.
- 🐾 **Pets over 6 months of age MUST be spayed or neutered.**
- 🐾 **Flea, Tick and Heartworm preventatives** – Required monthly.
- 🐾 **Please alert our staff if your pet has any allergies.**



Annual Daycare Contract

Hours of Operation: Monday – Friday 7:00am to 7:00Pm-drop off deadline by 10 AM. Half Day consists of any hours between 9:00am to 3:00pm or 7:00am to 1:00pm or no more than 6 hours.

Cancellations and No Show Fees: Please call the main office at 978-256-9555 to inform our staff if your pet will not be attending camp. Space is limited, therefore we require 24 hour cancellation notice. If we do not receive notice at least 1 day prior to a day we have reserved for your pet as marked on your submitted calendar, you will be charged a no show fee.

Health and Illness: All dogs must be in good health. Owners must certify that their dog is free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize the health and well-being of other dogs. Dogs with the following conditions (diarrhea, vomiting, coughing, sneezing, injury, limping, etc.) should **NOT** come to camp. Dogs must wait two weeks post-surgery to return to camp. **Dogs that are seriously ill or injured while at camp will be treated by a DVM at the owner's expense.** All dogs must be current on the following: Annual Wellness Exam, Rabies, Distemper, Bordetella (every 6 months), Canine Influenza, Leptospirosis, heartworm test and a negative fecal test.

Preventatives: All dogs at camp must be current on monthly flea & tick and heartworm preventatives.

Spay & Neuter: All dogs 6 months and older must be spayed or neutered to participate in camp.

As a condition of using our services for your pet, the following Owner Agreement must be signed. By choosing to utilize our services and have your pet participate in activities at Camp Countryside, I understand and agree to the following (please initial each of the following statements):

1. I understand and agree that Camp Countryside will determine if my dog passes the initial behavior assessment. If s/he does not pass the assessment, for the safety of all involved, my dog cannot participate in group play.
2. I understand and agree that Camp Countryside has the right to dismiss my dog from doggy day care for any reason.
3. I understand and agree that there are risks and benefits associated with group socialization of dogs. I agree that the benefits outweigh the risks and I accept the risk. I understand that while the socialization and play is closely monitored by Camp Countryside Staff, it is still possible that during the course of normal play, my dog may receive injury from roughhousing with other dogs. I understand that I will either receive a phone call regarding any injuries to my dog that require treatment or will be told about any minor injuries by staff upon pick-up.
4. **I understand that I am responsible for any and all medical expenses incurred as a result of injury to my dog while at Camp Countryside.**
5. I further understand and agree that Camp Countryside and their staff will not be liable for any problems that develop, provided reasonable care and precautions are followed, and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog's attendance and participation at Camp Countryside.
6. All fees to be paid at pick-up. **A late fee will be assessed for pets not picked up by 7:00pm.** I understand that if I do not pick up my pet before Countryside Veterinary Hospital closes, my pet will be transferred to overnight boarding and I am responsible for any additional fees incurred.
